The ragging incident will also be reported to the University and Director of Technical Education for further action. Further, the transfer Certificate Issued by the Institution will have a specific entry apart from that of general conduct and behavior whether a student has participated in and in particular been punished for ragging", as per the directive of the Honorable Supreme Court vide order dated4/5/2001.

In addition to the above, as per the orders of the Honorable Supreme court of India, "if any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the concerned student shall be given liberty to explain and if his explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would


