RULES AND REGULATIONS:

Eloction Competition:

- The speech may not exceed 2 minutes in duration.
- The time limit will be strictly enforced. A 30 second warning will be given.
- Points will be awarded based on the following criteria:
 - 1. Content
 - 2. Oratory skills
 - 3. Presentation skills
 - 4. Clarity of thought
 - 5. Confidence
- The decision of the judges will be final and no further queries will be entertained.

Essay Writing Competition:

- The essay should be written only in English and NOT MORE than 850 words long, excluding references.
- Use active voice, multiple paragraphs to make it readable.
- Add pictures to make it engaging and interesting.
- References: Books, articles or online sources that are cited should be listed at the end of the essay.
